


Uniform Exemption Process

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A parent / caregiver, house teacher, or the student (if independent) can use the Uniform Exemption Form.



The House Leader or Backup House Leader will consider the application for uniform exemption on a case-by-case basis.

A copy of the application marked *Exemption Pending* will be sent to the House Teacher of the student.



If the exemption is approved, the student's House Teacher is informed.

The student will be issued with an Exemption Card (similar to as shown below) with the details of the exemption printed on it.

If the exemption is approved on financial grounds, the Student Support Team are informed to decide whether access to Social Justice funds is appropriate for a uniform (or part thereof) to be supplied.

If the exemption is not approved the House Leader or Backup House Leader will provide details to the student or parent / caregiver via the House Teacher, House Leader or Backup House Leader.

Consequence

Consequences for non-compliance with uniform expectations can be:

- lunchtime detention
- "take home" to get into uniform
- Item borrowed from school uniform supply
- Access to social justice uniform voucher
